

## About Your Spelling Words

A prefix is a couple letters added to the beginning of a word to slightly change its meaning.

- The prefix **re** means again. In you <u>re</u>play a video, you are playing it again.
- The prefix **un** means not. If something is <u>un</u>known, it is *not* known.
- The prefix **dis** means not. If someone is <u>dis</u>honest, she is not being honest.
