

About Your Spelling Words

The suffix -ful means "full of." Powerful means "full of power." Thankful means "full of thanks."

The suffix -less means "without." Flawless means "without flaws." Fearless means "without fear."

The suffix -ly is used to change adjectives into adverbs. Look at the two sentences below.

My brother is sad.

My brother walked away sadly.

In the first sentence, the word <u>sad</u> is an adjective that describes my brother. In the second sentence, the word <u>sadly</u> is an adverb that describes how my brother walked.
